

THE 6TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RAILWAY STATIONS
Madrid, 19 - 21 October 2017

Following the successful editions held in Rome (2005), Paris (2007), Brussels (2011), Moscow (2013), and Marrakech (2015), the 6th NEXTSTATION International Conference on Railway Stations will take place in Madrid, Spain, from 19 to 21 October 2017. This high-profile global railway event on the themes of station development and operations, will be hosted by the Spanish Rail Infrastructure Manager, Adif, together with the International Union of Railways, UIC.

NEXTSTATION 2017 will be dedicated to the theme "Smart Stations in Smart Cities". Focusing on digitalization, this international event will also provide a unique opportunity for high-level speakers and panelists to address all strategic issues related to the creation, development and operation of railway stations, such as project development and financing, station management, station and urban planning, the sustainable, eco-friendly railway station, facilities and design, commercial use of station space and services, multimodality, accessibility and security.

Following its five previous editions, NEXTSTATION has become a benchmark event, a privileged venue for sharing information and experiences on the digitalization processes, concerning the development and operation of stations across the world. Developing a new generation of railway stations that meet the needs of information and mobility for travellers – whilst respecting the aims of sustainable development – is a strategic goal for all UIC Members.

TECHNICAL AND CULTURAL VISITS

Atocha Station in Madrid

It is Spain's main intermodal station, providing Commuter, Long and Medium Distance services as well as High Speed services.

Atocha was recently refurbished and enlarged to ensure more efficient High Speed arrivals and departures.

Atocha Station hosts one of Spain's main traffic control centres, a strategic technical element that is a showcase of Adif's technological capacities.



Málaga

In this beautiful southern city, located 2 hours 30 minutes away from Madrid by High Speed train, Adif manages one of the main stations in the country, Málaga Maria Zambrano, and the Vialia PPP project, one of the most successful examples of the combination of railway and commercial use of stations.

Málaga is also the capital of the world-famous Costa del Sol.

Toledo

This medieval city, located only 30 minutes away from Madrid, can also be reached by High Speed train. The station, built in 1919, is an architectural jewel with Moorish influence which is part of Spain's cultural heritage.

Toledo itself is a must-see place in Spain, with its finely preserved religious buildings and narrow streets, combining a rich, centuries-old cultural and artistic legacy.
